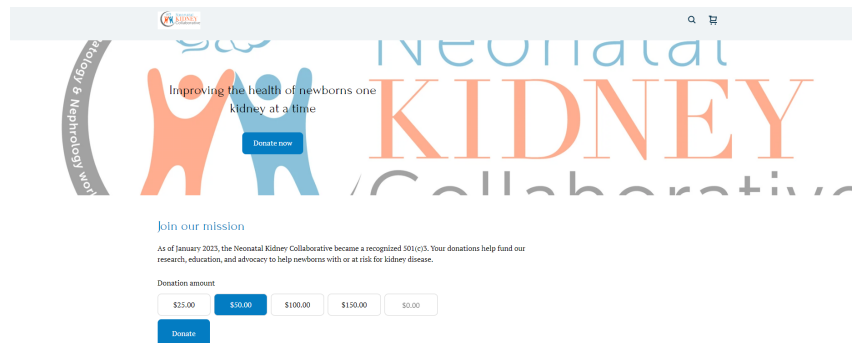
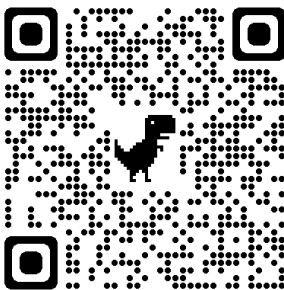
The latest from AWAKEN!
